POLICY FOR ALUMNI USE OF LTC

For 150 days after graduation, Florida Coastal alumni are given full access to the Florida Coastal Library and Technology Center's resources. After 150 days alumni are encouraged to register as an alumnus to retain access to most of the library's resources. Registered alumni that reside or work in the Jacksonville area will receive an Alumni Library Card and retain borrowing privileges for those resources in the collection that circulate. Alumni may also make interlibrary loan requests through the library homepage using the ILL link under "Services", or by filling out an ILL request form at the Reference Desk. Registration is valid for one year. Due to licensing agreements some of the library's electronic resources are not available to alumni.

FLORIDA RESEARCH RESOURCES:

Regional Collection: Florida Practice Materials

The LTC maintains a comprehensive collection of resources covering many areas of legal practice in Florida. These resources are located in the Regional Collection on the third floor of the LTC. The Regional Collection includes Florida practice materials from the Florida Bar Continuing Legal Education FasTrain Series and West's Florida Practice Series. The Regional Collection does not circulate but is available to all alumni for in-library use.

Regional Collection: Florida Cases, Statutes and Regulations

The Florida Regional Collection also includes extensive research resources for locating Florida state cases, federal cases originating in Florida and Florida statutes and government regulations. Resources from Thomson/West and LexisNexis, as well as Florida government and local publications, are all available to alumni for in-library use.

Florida Historical Collection

For alumni interested in Florida historical resources, the library has the Florida Historical Collection located on the first floor of the LTC. This collection includes *Florida Statutes* beginning with volume 1 (1927), and the *Laws of Florida* from 1893. The Florida Historical Collection does not circulate but is available to all alumni for in-library use.

Periodical Collection

The LTC's periodical collection includes most law reviews and legal journals published by schools and legal institutions in the state of Florida. The collection has all major Florida law reviews and journals beginning with the first volume published through to the current issue. The bound periodicals are located on the first floor of the LTC and do not circulate but are available for alumni for in-library use. The most recently published unbound periodicals are located behind the circulation desk on the third floor and are available to all alumni for in-library use.
