<i>Securities Regulation</i>	FL-BUSI-315	1	SECURITIES REGULATION: This course provides a survey of the primary authorities that regulate securities (e.g. stocks and bonds), and the law and strategies involved in seeking exemptions from regulation. The primary learning objective is to have students navigate the minefield of rules that allow companies to sell stock without incurring substantial penalties or imprisonment. There will be several simulations to achieve that objective where students will play various roles in the actual sale of a company's stock. Those roles include the attorney advising companies intending to sell stock to the public, the potential investors, and Securities and Exchange Commission regulators that will attempt to block the sales. <i>Taking and Defending Effective Depositions</i>	FL-DSRL-311	1	TAKING AND DEFENDING EFFECTIVE DEPOSITIONS: The ability to take and defend depositions effectively, and to prepare clients and witnesses for deposition are critical, yet often overlooked Simulation essential to every advocate. Good depositions can make a case, while bad ones can blow it. This course will cover deposing experts, lay witnesses, and adverse parties; preparing witnesses and clients for depositions, defending depositions, problem depositions, using depositions at trial, strategies and tactics, special and ethical considerations. <i>Wrongful Convictions</i>	FL-CRIM-313	1	WRONGFUL CONVICTIONS: The overall objective of the course is to create an awareness of the magnitude of the problem of wrongful convictions in the U.S., problems that lead to the conviction of the innocent and to explore possible reforms to prevent such. Topics that will be covered include problems in the criminal justice system such as ineffective assistance of counsel, police and prosecutorial misconduct especially in the use of informants, mistakes in eyewitness identification and false confessions. Political, economic, sociological and cultural variables affecting convictions will also be explored.
